Course Requirements

Assignment Submissions

Assignment worksheets are designed as fillable PDFs, meaning that once students download the file, they will be able to respond to the assignment questions in spaces provided in the PDF.

Please be mindful of the word count, if specified, under each question or topic.

Once the assignment is completed (i.e. all questions and topics have been responded to), please save and upload your completed assignment worksheet at the same place you downloaded the file. There should be an option for you to upload a file (see picture below).

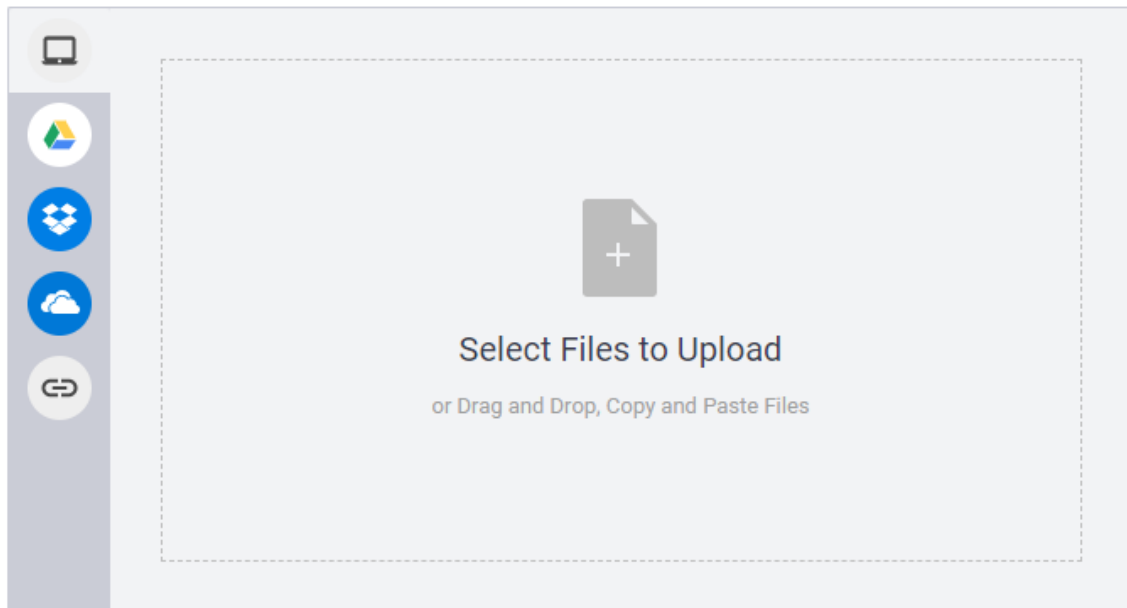

Zoom Meetings

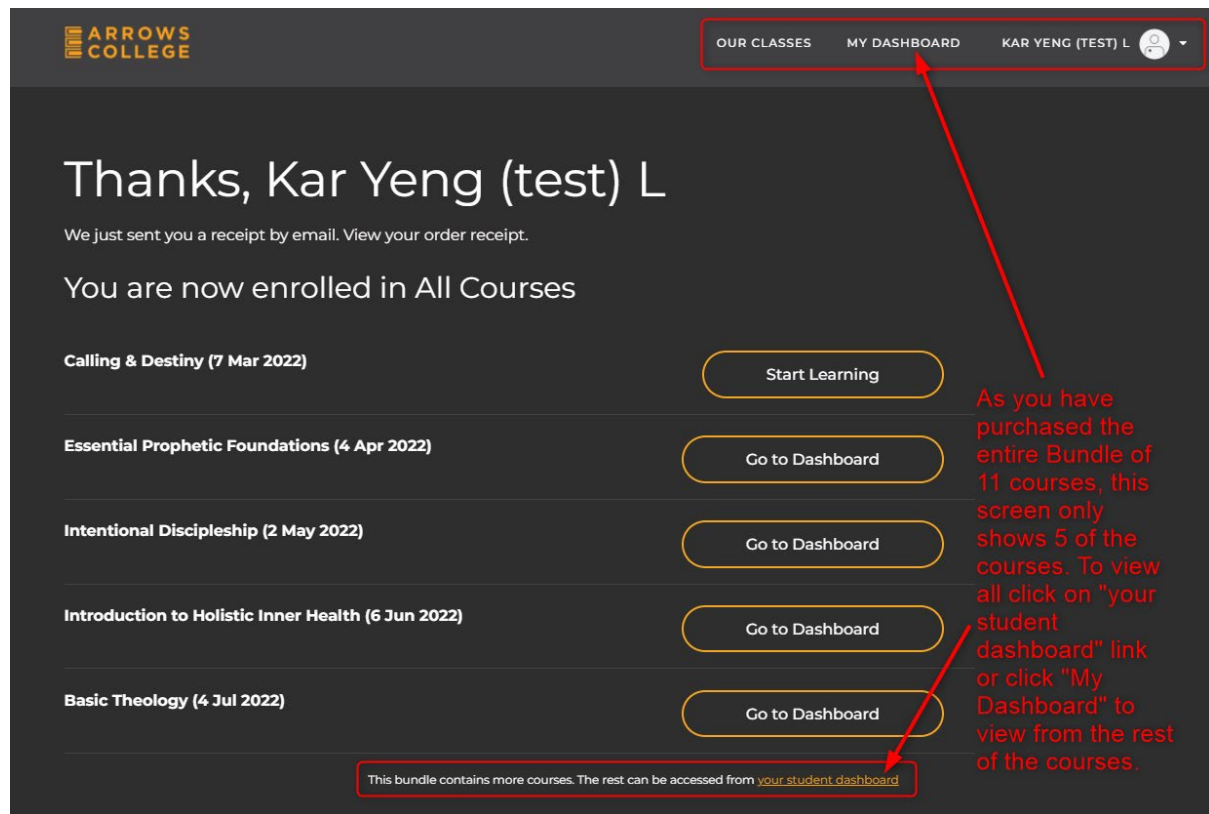

Follow the naming guidelines for **Discussion Posts** specified above. Just make a note that you are unable to attend the Zoom meeting so that the module facilitator/instructor can take note of your absence.

Meeting recordings are not guaranteed for all Zoom meetings. Where it is relevant to do so, Zoom meetings will be recorded. Zoom meetings will not be recorded if they are purely ministry based, meaning that the purpose of the Zoom meeting was to minister directly to students. In these cases, recorded Zoom meetings will not be relevant to those not personally in attendance.

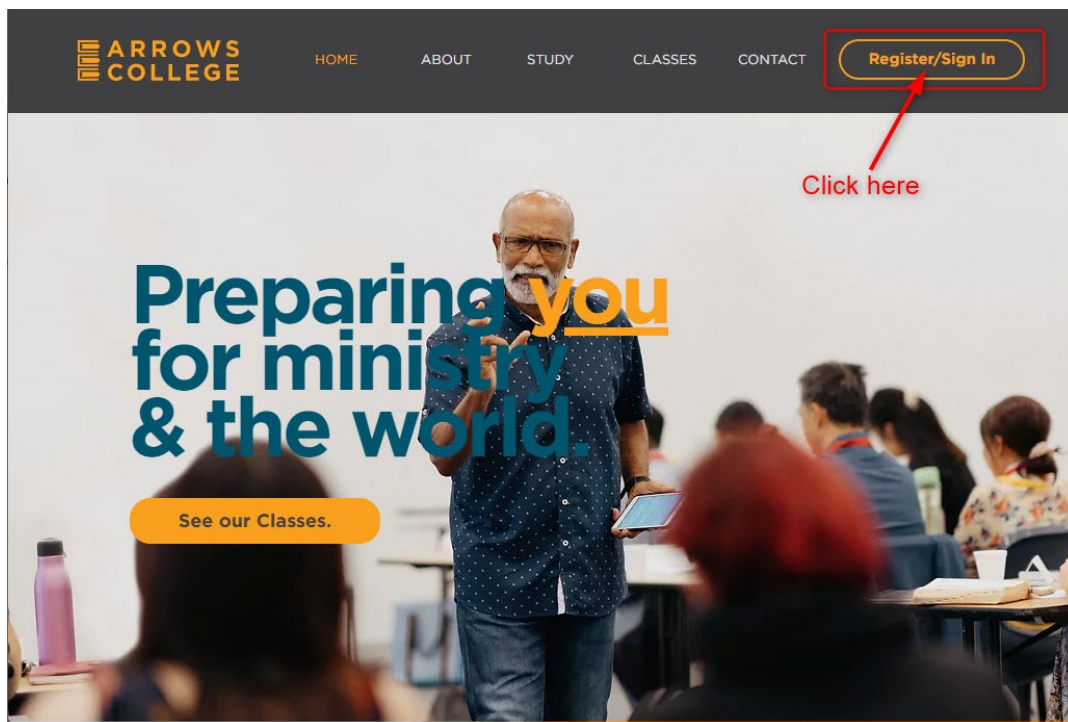

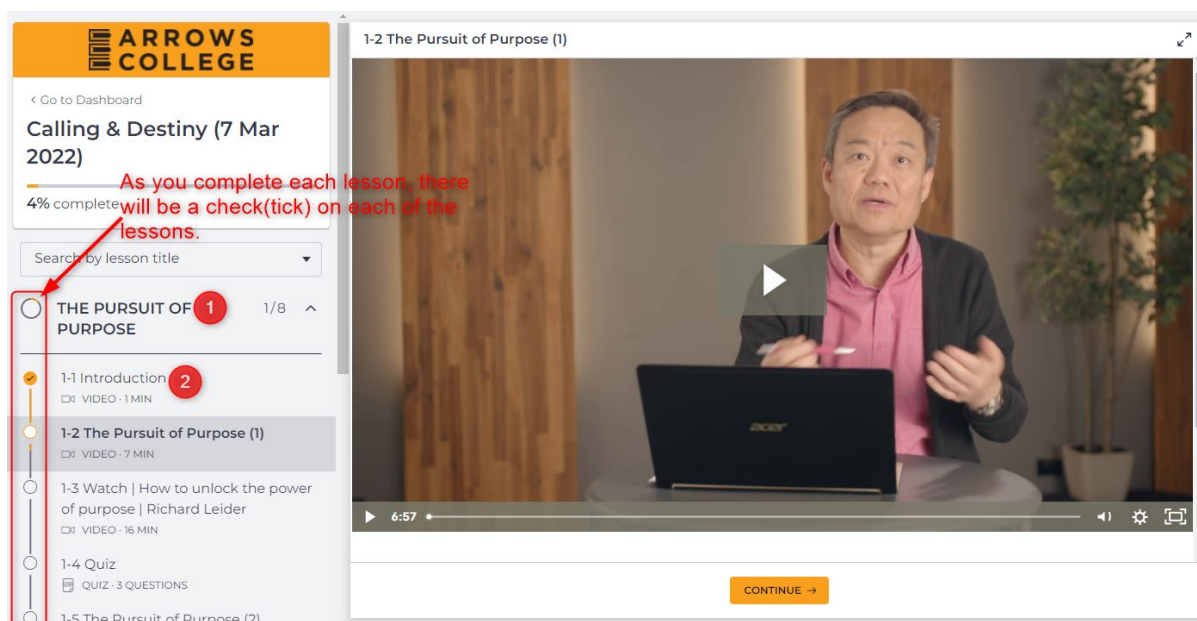

To assist the students with the courses, we have the start date of every course on the header so they know which ones they need to focus on. For example, you can see “Calling & Destiny” will start on 7 Mar 2022, “Going Missional” will start on 3 Apr 2023, etc.

Navigating the Course

When the course is released, for example on March 7th, all the Lessons will be available on that date.



The screen above is an example of “Calling & Destiny” course.

Some things to note from the screen:

1. ***The Pursuit of Purpose*** – is the Topic or what the system calls Chapter. When you complete all the lessons within that Topic, the round bullet will turn orange with a check(tick).
2. ***1-1 Introduction*** is the first Lesson within the Topic. In order to complete the Topic “***The Pursuit of Purpose***” you need to see a check against every Lesson (i.e. 1-1, 1-2, 1-3, etc) within the Topic.

When a Course is released, this means every single Topic & its Lessons will be available to the student. You can view the videos, read the Reading Materials, attempt the quizzes, etc. As this is an online course, the student can access the entire course and go through them at their own pace.

For example, if the course is released on March 7th, the students don’t have to start on that date. They can virtually start any day or time that is convenient or suitable for them. However, there are two interactive Lessons e.g. Zoom sessions scheduled for this course. (*Note: Every course will be different - some have only one Zoom session, some may have more or none*) These Zoom sessions are mandatory and if a student wants to gain a Certificate of Completion, they must attend the session at the scheduled time. Some Zoom sessions may be recorded for those who are really unable to attend. However, live attendance is strongly recommended. When attending the Zoom session, it would be beneficial for the student to complete every

Lesson prior to the Zoom Lesson so that they are able to gain the most benefit and also to participate in the Lesson.



The video settings are also similar to say, YouTube. You can advance the video if you like, change the volume, brightness, speed, quality and also toggle to fullscreen if you wish.

Workbooks

It is also important to pay attention to the Lesson as there are Workbooks to be downloaded. Before you click “Continue”, you will see there is a Workbook available for download.

Click “Download” and a new screen will display with the Workbook. Depending on the browser you use, it may look different. If you have any issues downloading the Workbook, please get some help from someone locally as we are not able to provide IT support.

Quiz

A lesson may contain a Quiz. An example is shown below. Just answer by selecting an answer or as directed by the question and click “Confirm” to move to the next question.

Reading Material


If a Lesson has Reading Material, click to Download the material.


As per the Workbook, a screen on a new tab on your browser will display and you may download the Reading Material to your computer or print it to read.

Assignment

An Assignment lesson will look something like this:



Click to download the Worksheet which is a fillable PDF. As with the Workbook and Reading Material, a screen in a new tab on your browser will display.

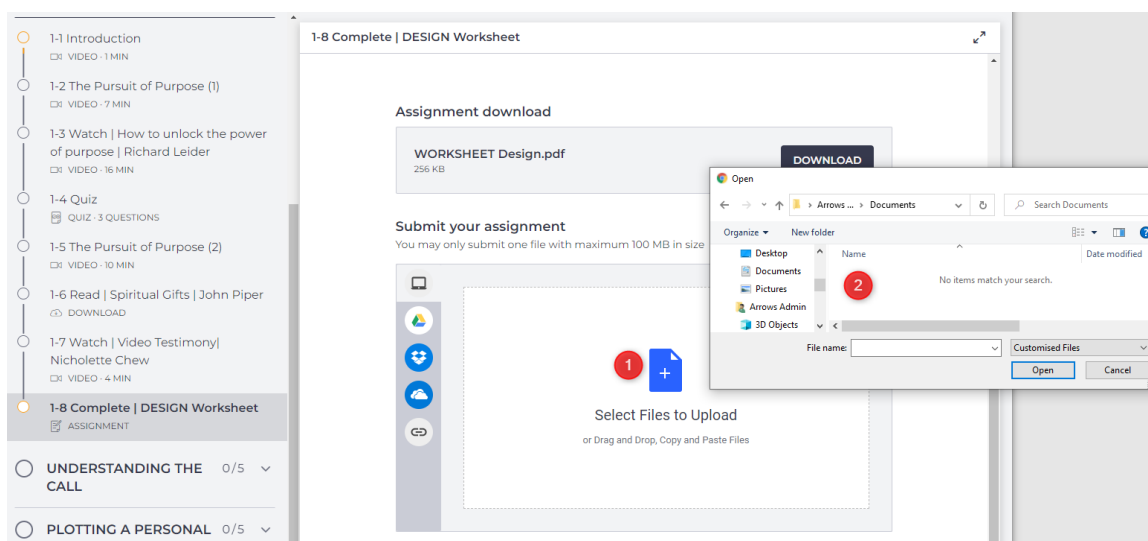


You may opt to start typing to answer the assignment as shown in the screenshot above, or you may wish to download the document.

We do not suggest the student to print the document – if they do so and handwrite the assignment, they will need to scan the document and upload it as one document back to the LMS (Learning Management System).

It is preferable that the student type directly on the Fillable PDF document, then save it on their computer and later rename (as explained in the

Assignment Submission section) the document before uploading it to the Lesson.



To upload the assignment, either

1. click and drag your assignment file (that you have saved on your computer) to the upload area (see above), or left-click on the upload area.
2. When you click on the upload area, a window will appear asking you to select the file you want to upload. Navigate to where you have saved your assignment file and click “open.” Once you have selected the file to upload, click “upload” in the bottom-right corner to complete the upload process.

If the student is not familiar navigating the computer, please have someone locally to assist them.
